Description of Position

This position is responsible for the Men's LCC Basketball Team including recruitment, retention, and completion of student athletes as well as managing the overall operations of the LCC gym. Performs all functions and activities within the guidelines and philosophy set forth in the LCC Mission, Vision, Strategic and Athletic Department Plan.

Duties & Responsibilities

The successful candidate will have the following responsibilities:

Perform all duties of Head Coach of the LCC Men's Basketball Team, including:

- Develop and maintain a competitive basketball team that will effectively supplement the educational experience of student athletes
- Understand and follow all rules and regulations governing Northwest Athletic Conference (NWAC) athletic programs in addition to the NWAC rules governing basketball, especially in matters pertaining to recruitment and eligibility of student athletes
- Oversee and delegate duties to assistant coach consistent with expectations regarding NWAC and college policy compliance
- Organize fundraising activities with the specific purpose of enhancing the basketball program
- Participate in Athletic Department activities including department meetings, outreach and fundraising events as requested
- Work collaboratively with college personnel to track and monitor the academic progress of basketball athletes
- Participate in quarterly advising sessions for the athletes to better understand academic and transfer requirements
- Responsible for reporting team scores and other appropriate game statistics to the NWAC office after home contests or away contests in which the opponent is not an NWAC member
- Collaborate with LCC athletic department to develop web site/media/promotional materials for the basketball program
- Work cooperatively with the Athletic Department staff, developing collaborative and collegial relationships with the other coaches in the department
- Understand and follow the policies and procedures of the Athletic Department

- Manage and operate the LCC men's basketball program within budget
 Manages overall operations of LCC's Myklebust Gymnasium, providing needed services to Instruction, Student Services, Fitness Center and Athletics programs.

- Supervise and maintain laundry room and supplies
- Responsible for supervision and maintenance of training room and work with Athletic Trainer to order supplies
- Assists Athletic Director in evaluating facilities and equipment, helping to ensure the safety of equipment and the gymnasium facility
- Work with Athletic Department to make sure all Gymnasium equipment like scoreboards, shot clocks, scorers tables, etc are in good working order
- Coordinate and manage gymnasium signage
- Supervise work study students
- Advocate for gender equity in the LCC athletic department
- Perform in an ethical manner, consistent with the college's mission and values
