## **Next LCC art exhibit showcases work of Washington community college faculty**

The Art Gallery at Lower Columbia College will host the Washington Community College Humanities Association's "Crosscurrents 30th Anniversary Traveling Exhibit" Jan. 24–Feb. 24, 2012. The public is invited to three free exhibit, as well as the opening reception Jan. 23 from 4 until 6 p.m.

The exhibit features 25 years of art, broadsides, and printed poetry by Washington community college faculty, originally published in Crosscurrents, the WCCHA annual magazine.

The show includes art by current and retired Lower Columbia College faculty Ray Lynn Cooper, Rosemary Powelson and Yvette (O'Neill) Raynham. Joe Green, retired English faculty, and his wife Marquita, will show their *peasandcues press* printed broadsides of Joe's poetry and that of other WCCHA members.

The gallery, located in the Rose Center for the Arts, at 15<sup>th</sup> Avenue and Washington Way, will be open Mondays and Tuesdays, 10 a.m. until 6 p.m., and Wednesday–Friday, 10 a.m. until 4 p.m.
